HORNET TRAP

HIGHLY EFFECTIVE TRAP*

Specially developed to trap Asian hornets

- The yellow bowl colour is known to attract Asian hornets.
- The shape of the trap concentrates the odour of the attractant and allows a better diffusion and efficacy.
- The trap lid provides two entrances, both covered with a tunnel that focuses and directs odours, shields ambient light, and prevents hornets from escaping.

The trap is easy to use and specially designed to attract hornets and prevent them from escaping.

TIPS FOR USE

Position traps in areas where asian hornets fly (hives, swimming pools, terraces, shelves, trees, etc.)

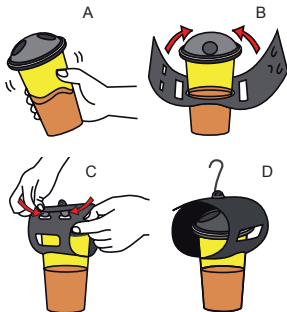
- **In height:** traps hanging from a branch (1.5 to 3 metres from the ground)
- **Close to flight boards:** On the ground or on a support

Number of traps depending on the number of hornets per hive:

2 hornets per hive = 1 trap for 2 hives

3 to 5 hornets per hive = 1 trap per hive

5 hornets per hive = 3 traps for 2 hives



According to a study carried out by the ITSAP in 2014* in 2 French departments, the Vétô-pharma trap shows the best level of hornet catch at the end of the trapping season.

Thoroughly mix the following ingredients in the trap bowl:
10ml of attractant
50g of sugar
200ml of water

At saturation of hornets or 3 weeks after placement, **renew the solution** without rinsing the bowl of the trap.



- It takes a **few hours** for the traps to catch hornets.
- If the traps do not catch any hornet, **it may be useful to reposition them.**
- It is recommended to trap when the maximum **daily temperatures exceed 15 °C.**
- It is recommended to trap **in areas of passage** of the Asian hornet.
- For better efficiency, **do not clean the trap** during the renewal of the solution.
- When renewing the attractive, we recommend to **leave a dead hornet in the trap.**



WHEN TO USE THE TRAPS?

SPRING TRAPPING

OBJECTIVE:

Limit the number of founders and therefore the number of future nests, and thus help to reduce the pressure of autumn attacks.



Caution: Spring trapping must be done in a targeted manner to reduce the risk of trapping other species. Traps should be placed on Asian hornet ways: near apiaries, near the site of old nests, etc.

AUTUMN TRAPPING

OBJECTIVE:

Decrease the pressure of the Asian hornet in the apiary, which is high at this time because the hornets look for a food rich in sugar. **This trapping must be heavily put in place to protect the colonies likely to be strongly attacked and depopulated.**
